1. 从7月去考试的学生回忆上看，话题基本都是稳定在题库里，只要做好充分准备，提前准备好思路，part1并不是很难。
2. 对于想要冲口语高分的学生，part1可能也要好好准备下，因为part1有些题很类似于part3的题型，只用3-4句话很难答得漂亮，比如：Why do many people want to be famous through singing? 所以想要口语取得高分的学生，part1则要好好准备了。

相较于 part 1, Part 2 则相对来说稳定一些。从考生反馈情况看，学生大多考的话题还是学习及生活相关的。如 Describe something you do to keep you concentrated; Describe a piece of technology(not computer-related) you like to use 等。所以在8月之后的考生在复习的方向上，对于学习生活类的话题要多花点时间，可作为重点复习对象。

这个季度 Part 3 的题则相对更灵活多变，很多时候学生很难自己把握住。且很多题和学生的生活相差较远 比如说“what's the relationship between money and happiness”学生普遍看到这个抽象的题会有点懵，很多学生就只会阐述一个关系，但是没有意识要给一些例子来具体说明。有的即使有思路，词汇量局限的也很难发挥好。所以 part3 如果有时间最好也稍微多准备一下，万一问到讲义上的题，能抓住机会发挥好。
